

CONNECT2 KENILWORTH SCHEME

A429 COVENTRY ROAD – NEW CYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

As you are aware, as part of the Connect2 Kenilworth Scheme, we will be installing a new bridge where the old railway line (now known as The Greenway) use to cross the A429 Coventry Road, Kenilworth.



Preparation Works

To prepare for the installation of the new bridge, our contractors (Currell Lewis & Martin) have been constructing new foundations and abutments on the embankments either side of the A429. The majority of these works are complete.

Installation of the New Bridge

The new steel bridge is being fabricated at a dedicated facility and will be delivered to site as one unit.

The bridge will arrive on site on a low loader and will be craned onto the foundations by a mobile crane.

The delivery of the footbridge, and the craning of the bridge will take place during a weekend (overnight) closure of the A429.

When will the work be taking place?

The footbridge will be installed overnight on Saturday 10th September 2011. In the event that the bridge cannot be installed on this date, it will be carried out on the following weekend.

What can I expect to see at the site during the bridge installation?

The A429 will be closed to through traffic, and diversion signs will be erected along the diversion route. Access to frontages will be maintained.

On site there will be a 300 tonne crane positioned on the A429. The crane will take up the whole width of the road.

There will also be a low loader vehicle used to transport the bridge to the site.

In order to safely install the bridge, the site will be flood lit.
